Sports Premium Funding at Ashdene Primary School

This year Ashdene received **£19,480** in sports premium grant money.

The funding is to create a culture in our school that encourages all children to be active and enjoy sport.

The aim of spending the sports premium is to make sustainable changes where teachers and coaches deliver high quality PE lessons and children develop a love of an active lifestyle.

Membership of the MSSP and WEP	The MSSP Membership (Macclesfield School Sports Partnership) and WEP (Wilmslow Educational Partnership) provides us with access to a range of PE training, and access to specialist PE teachers and coaches who can work with both staff and children at Ashdene, enhancing PE provision. A wide variety of Sports Events are organised for many of our pupils to participate and experience competitions and Festivals with other local schools.	£1260	Children's involvement and participation in a range of Level 2 and Level 3 sporting events, leading to greater depth of learning of relevant skills, teamwork and sportsmanship. Enhanced PE provision with in-class support. Young Sports Ambassadors established to promote activities within school and at external events to develop leadership skills.
Curriculum Development	Multi-skills Club. This club was set up to target children who required additional PE support or who were on the least active register.	£1600	There are fewer less active children than 2017-18. 55% of the children from the KS2 least active register are now active.
Repairs to playground equipment	Playground equipment to be replaced and repaired where necessary	£1129	Children are encouraged to be active during break and lunchtimes. Less children are standing around inactively.



Standing up desks	To encourage children to be active while working. These were trailed in Year Four but it is unlikely that they will be using throughout the school at present.	£1122	Children have spent less time sitting while working throughout the day.
Sporting events at Ashdene and staffing to external events	Ashdene run a variety of sporting events. This cost covers a range of consumables such as medals, certificates, engraving, administration and refreshments as required. Also TA staffing of external events.	£1840	Increases opportunities for more children to engage in more competitive sports in a supportive environment. Leadership opportunities are developed for many of our older pupils taking various key roles in the success of these events. A greater sense of belonging to the school community is developed.
Running Track	To encourage children to be active a running track will be constructed at Ashdene. The payment for this will be spread over three years starting in 2018.	£11,947	Children to engage in more physical activities every day.
Football Kits	To develop our school community and identity new football kits were purchased.	£582	Children are proud it represent Ashdene in football competitions.
