The funding is to create a culture in our school that encourages all children to be active and enjoy sport.

A key focus is to buy in support that will help to improve the quality of sports and PE provision.

<b>Membership of the MSSP and WEP</b>	The MSSP Membership (Macclesfield School Sports Partnership) and WEP (Wilmslow Education Partnership) provides us with access to a range of PE training, and access to specialist PE teachers and coaches who can work with both staff and children at Ashdene, enhancing PE provision. A wide variety of Sports Events are organised for many of our pupils to participate and experience competitions and Festivals with other local schools.	<b>£1500</b>	Children's involvement and participation in a range of Level 2 and Level 3 sporting events, leading to greater depth of learning of relevant skills, teamwork and sportsmanship. Enhanced PE provision with in-class support. Young Sports Ambassadors established to promote activities within school and at external events to develop leadership skills.
<b>Sporting events at Ashdene and staffing to external event</b>	Ashdene run a variety of sporting events. This cost covers a range of consumables such as medals, certificates, engraving, administration and refreshments as required. Also staffing of external events.	<b>£1500</b>	Increases opportunities for more children to engage in more competitive sports in a supportive environment. Leadership opportunities are developed for many of our older pupils taking various key roles in the success of these events. A greater sense of belonging to the school community is developed.
<b>Running track</b>	To encourage children to be active a running track will be constructed at Ashdene. The payment for this will be spread over three years starting in 2018.	<b><u>£13,057 approx.</u></b>	Children to engage in more physical activities every day.
<b>PE Resources</b>	Providing new PE equipment and replacing old, worn	<b>£2000</b>	The PE coordinator, along with class teachers, will
