

Dictionaries

Look through an age appropriate dictionary and find other words with the same spelling rule as your word list.

Add any new words to the spelling lists in your spelling journal.

If your spelling pattern includes a phoneme in the middle or the end of the word, try creating rhyming strings from some of the words from your list, e.g. stream, cream, team, bream, theam (theme). Then search your dictionary to investigate if these are real words and follow your spelling pattern.

If it is a word you have not experienced before, read the definition and say or write these new words in sentences.

Dictionaries

Look through your reading book and find other words with the same spelling rule as your word list.

Add any new words to the spelling lists in your spelling journal.

If it is a word you have not experienced before, check the definition in your dictionary and practise saying or writing these new words in sentences.

Dictionaries

Read through the phoneme spotter story for your spelling pattern.

Find the words with the correct spelling of the phoneme and add any new words to the spelling lists in your spelling journal.

If it is a word you have not experienced before, check the definition in your dictionary and practising saying or writing these new words in sentences.

Have a go at writing your own phoneme story, using the list you have created!
