

Friday's writing

Here is the front and back cover of the Kid Normal book.





Their cover is intended to entice readers through humour. The blurb is important: you want to give enough information to make people want to know more, but not too much that you give the whole story away. Blurbs usually include at least one question.

E.g.

There are!? Oh right okay then.

Will they be able to defeat the evil Dr and save the world?
