### Maths

#### Green

Isaac had 10 sweets. He ate 7. Show this by drawing a grid like the one above.

Then write the number sentence.

$$10 - 7 = 3$$

Make up 3 more subtraction number sentences of your own.

#### Yellow

Claudia had 20 grapes. She ate 15. Show this as a number sentence.  $20 - 15 = 5$

Of the 15 grapes Claudia ate, 7 were red and the rest were green.  $15 - 7 = 8$

Molly ate 9 grapes. How many more did Claudia eat?  $15 - 9 = 6$
