Subject and verbs.

A subject - a person, place, thing or idea that is doing or being something.

A verb - the action that describes what the subject is doing

Can you find the verb in these sentences?

- I ran across the park.
- Tom jumped into the swimming pool.

- It was her birthday so she unwrapped lots of presents.
