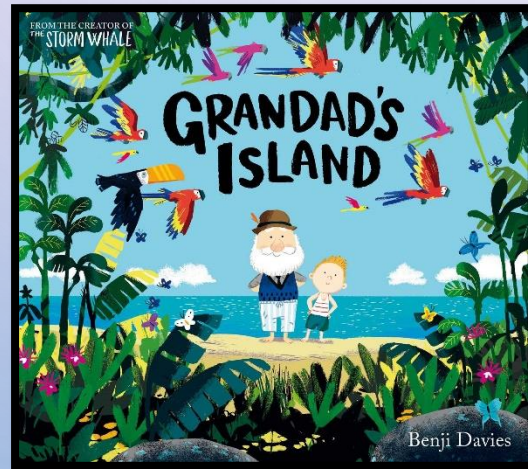


Monday 11th May 2020

Can you remember where it lead to after Syd turned the handle and pushed the door?





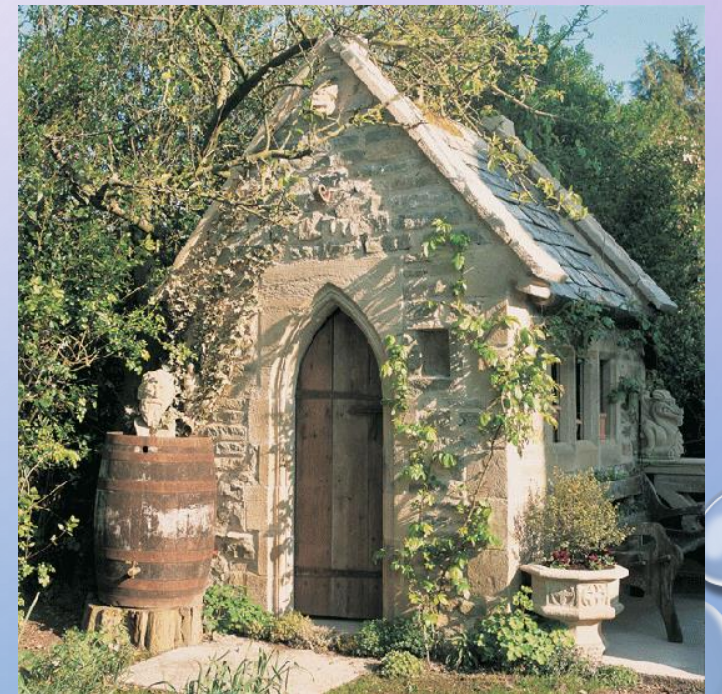
That's right! Syd found himself standing

Literacy Activity

Can you draw a picture of what we would find behind your secret door and then write about it?



Literacy Activity

Green: List 4/5 things we would find behind your secret door OR write a sentence about where your secret door takes you.

Amber: List 4/5 things we would find behind your secret door and write a sentence about where your secret door takes you.

Red: List 6 or more things we would find behind your secret door, and write a sentence about where your secret door takes you. Try to use **describing words** (adjectives)
