Answers

Whales- live in deep in the ocean. They would not survive on land. They do need to come to the water surface though to breathe. They don't breathe underwater, they hold their breath. They can do this for up to 1 hour!

Turtles- Although turtles are born on the coast, they live in the ocean. They too need to come to the water surface to breathe. They can hold their breath for a couple of hours. If they are resting, they can hold their breath for up to 7 hours!

Crabs- The crabs we see in England live on the coast. However there are different types of crabs that live in the water.

Seals- They live on the coast. Although they go into the water to catch their food. Cod fish are one of their favourite things to eat!

Mussels- They live in shallow waters on the coast. They attach themselves to rocks so they don't get washed away by the waves.

Octopus- They live in the ocean. They like to live at the bottom of the ocean on coral reefs because they like to hide in rock caves.

Starfish- They can live in shallow waters on the coast in rocks pools or on coral reefs.

Fish- They live in the ocean. Small fish will come to shallow waters but they wouldn't survive if they were washed up onto the sand.

Dolphins- They live in the ocean. They too, will sometimes come close to the coast but they wouldn't survive if they were washed up onto the sand.
