Remember that non-fiction books often have the following features:

- a front cover with a photograph to show what it is about
- a **contents** page that tells you what each chapter or page is about
- information divided into different **chapters** or sections, with a **sub-heading** at the start of each new one
- a **glossary** at the end, that explains the meaning of any special words to do with the topic.

Carrying on from your work yesterday, making a non-fiction book, today we would like you to think about what your chapters or sections might be about and write down the subheadings you might use.

eg. If you were writing about how to look after a cat, you might have the sub-headings
