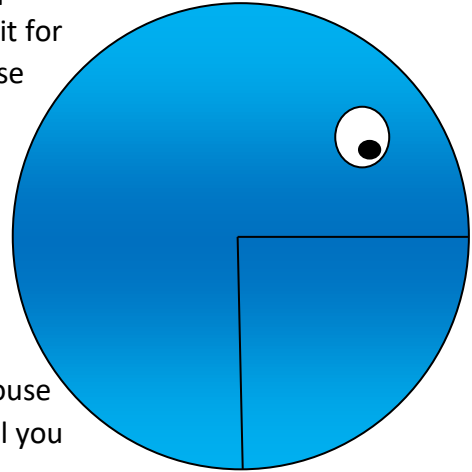


Wednesday

Today's investigation is going to be all about right angles. Can you remember when we investigated right angles in the classroom with our right angle eaters? Well you are going to do the same at home.

Here is one of the angle eaters from school. If you can't print this document at home you can ask a grown up to draw it for you. Don't forget you need to cut out the 'mouth' and use this bit to check for right angles.



First, look over the angles PowerPoint uploaded on the website to refresh your memory about acute, obtuse and right angles.

You are then going to investigate these angles in your house and in your garden. First make a prediction of which angle you think is going to be the most common.

You can record your results any way you want- photographs, tally chart, a video. We would love to see what angles you find at home.
