

Friday – lines

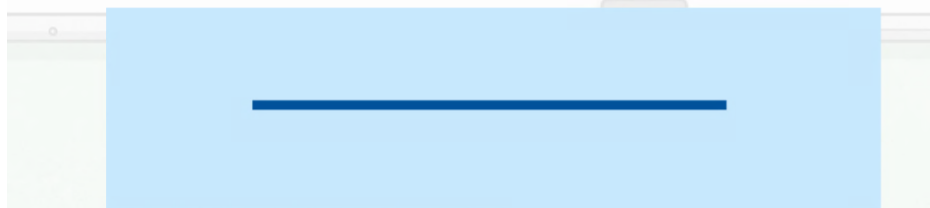
Today we would like you to have a go finding horizontal and vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines. You have **two** tasks to complete.

To remind yourself of these lines have a look at the picture below and watch the video on parallel and perpendicular lines.

We can describe lines as horizontal or vertical.

A **horizontal** line runs across, from left to right (or right to left):



A **vertical** line runs up and down:



Task one

Find as many lines as you can around your house, in your garden or on a walk. See if you can find at least 4 examples of each. You can present your work using photos, Powerpoint, PicCollage, drawings etc.

Task two

We would like you to have a go at writing your name using 3D letters. There is a great video below that shows you how to write each letter of the alphabet using 3D drawing.

Once you have drawn your name, we would like you to count how many horizontal and vertical lines you have in your name. As an extra challenge, see if you can count how many pairs of parallel lines you have in your name and whether you have any perpendicular lines.
