### Place Value

Using the link find the pairs – each number needs to be matched wit the digit.

As you read a word you could write down the number you are looking for.

## Green

- Ask an adult to write a selection of numbers on some post-its or pieces of paper. Initially 0-10 extend beyond 10 if your child is confident.
- Create a display of what that number looks like.
  - Write out the number as a word
  - Find an object of that many
  - Can you find the correct number of objects to make that number?
  - Find the number on a measurement

E.g. – the number 5 written on the post -it

I write out five (as a word)
I find 5 paperclips
I use 5 pencils to make the number 5
I find 5 on the tag in my school jumper

#### Yellow

- Ask an adult to say a number 0-30 and create a display of what that number looks like.
  - Write out the number as a word sixteen
  - Write the number as a digit 16
  - Find an object of that many 16 books
  - Can you find the correct number of objects to make that number? 16 grapes arrange to show the number 16
  - ❖ Find the number on a measurement 10.16 on the clock
  - ❖ Show the number using tens and ones − a packet of ten biscuits and 6 individual biscuits.
