

Parts of a Plant



Plants sometimes grow <u>fruits</u>. These will contain seeds that will grow into new plants. Some fruits are toxic to animals.

<u>Leaves</u> catch sunlight to make energy for the plant.



The <u>stem</u> supports a plant. It carried water from the roots to the rest of the plant.
