Monday Teach words

Focusing on words that have 2 consonants next to each other at beginning or end of a word- e.g. clap or nest. Sometimes children can miss out sounds when there are 2 consonants together. Help them to notice these consonants and try to say the consonants quickly e.g. cl or st. They can also try to read the first 3 sounds in a word and then add the last one e.g. c-l-a-cla- clap or n-e-s- nes- nest.

Write the words into your book, add sound buttons correctly and then read each word. Spot the consonant clusters.

spin clip grab rest pink jump

Answers- red letters are the consonant clusters.
