This week's spellings to learn are:

very happy funny rocky dirty tidy pretty lovely quickly softly

This week we are going revisit some of the trickier sounds we should know before heading into Year 2.

Monday 6th July 2020

Today's sound is <u>air</u> as in that's not fair

Have a look at the link https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uZHKK9jnfFQ how many air words can you write down while the clip is playing?

Use the air words you have written down to write some sentences. These can be as silly as you like but they must make sense.

The bear liked to have fairy wings in his hair.

If you feel confident you could try creating a short story using as many air words as you can.

Tuesday 7th July 2020

Today's sound is <u>ue</u> as in give me a clue

Wednesday 8th July 2020

Today's sound is <u>ew</u> as in chew some stew

Thursday 9th July 2020 & Friday 10th July 2020

Over the next 2 days we are looking at compound words.

A coumpound word is where 2 smaller words are joined together to make another word with a different meaning.

Such as <u>rain</u> and <u>bow</u> they combine together to make <u>rainbow</u>.

Here is a link to show you how to do it. You can stop the video at any time to have a go at writing the compound words before they are revealed. The video is quite long so you do not have to watch it all.
