

Year 1 Phonics and spellings Week 7

This week's spellings to learn are:

football	playground	farmyard	bedroom
butterfly	handbag	rainbow	
snowman	popcorn	evergreen	

This week we are going to revisit some of the trickier sounds we should know before heading into Year 2.

Monday 13th July 2020

Today's sound is **a_e** as in bake a cake

Have a look at the link <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=f0aCGmNNI-s> how many a-e words can you write down while the clip is playing?

Use the words you have written down, write some sentences. These can be as silly as you like but they must make sense.

The baker makes cakes to feed to the snakes.

If you feel confident you could try creating a short story using as many a-e words as you can.

Tuesday 14th July 2020

Today's sound is **e_e** as in these numbers are even

Using the Boggle grid below how many e_e words can you create?

t	n	l	s
x	r	o	i
v	d	h	a
m	p	g	c

e is not in the grid, but you can use it in each word on its own or as a split digraph.

Wednesday 15th July 2020

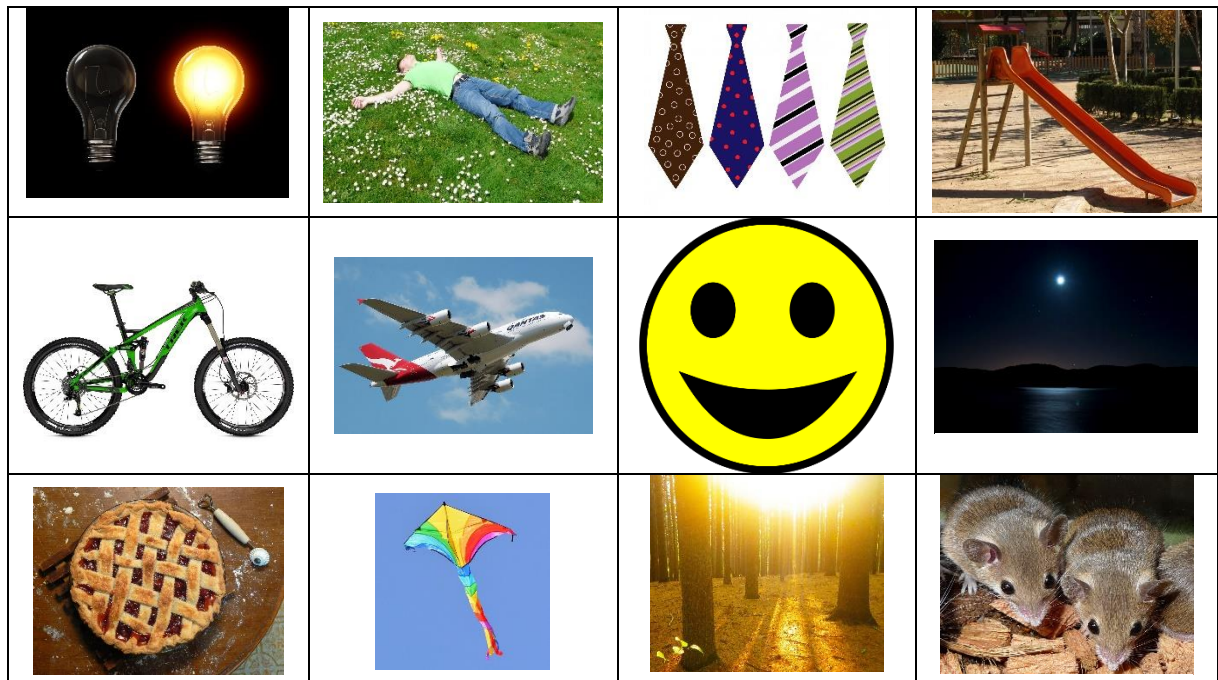
Today's sound is **i_e** as in nice smile
