  - She dreams she is trying to rescue her mum from the house fire but 'it had been locked from the inside'

2. Look at the sentences following '*I turned to go back to bed*' to the end of the text. How does the narrator feel in this section? Use evidence from the text to support your answer. (3 marks)

Your answer should have at least 3 parts. This could be Point + Evidence and another point (2 points with evidence for at least one). Or it could be Point + Evidence + Evidence (2 pieces of evidence for the same point)
