Booking Information

To ensure we can staff the club appropriately and meet safeguarding requirements, **all children must be pre-booked online**. If your child is not booked in, they will not be able to attend.

Each child must be booked separately using the links below. Booking closes **four school weeks before the session starts**.

Example: For the week of April 22-25, bookings close at 9 AM on Tuesday, March 11.

Late bookings will not be accepted, as we need time to arrange staffing and order food. We want to ensure that we **only staff the club for the number of children actually attending**, as the school receives just 60p per child per day to cover all staffing and food costs.

Cancellations

To help us manage numbers effectively, we require at least one full week's notice for cancellations.

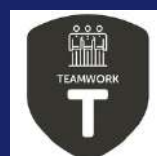

If your child does not attend or if you cancel with less than a week's notice three times in a term (except for non-attendance at school due to illness), they will lose their place for the rest of the term.

Children Attending Holiday Zone Breakfast Club

We have worked with Holiday Zone to ensure a 60p per day discount for children attending this provision. This will be applied as a credit to future bookings, and Holiday Zone will contact families directly.

Holiday Zone's standard drop-off from 7.30AM remains available at an additional charge.



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Drop-off

To ensure a smooth and structured start to the day:

Drop-off is only between 8:25 – 8:35 AM so breakfast can be served before class. If you arrive after 8:35 AM, your child will not be admitted and must wait with you until the regular school doors open.

An adult dropping children off will be required to sign in each child.

Breakfast Menu

The booking form will ask if your child requires breakfast, helping us reduce food waste.

Initially, breakfast will include buttered toast and fruit.

Any allergies or medical needs will be catered for based on existing school records.

Children must bring their own water bottles (refill station available).

To ensure a quick and efficient drop-off, staff will not be able to pass messages to class teachers during Breakfast Club. Instead, please use:

Lateness

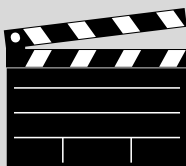

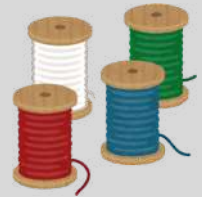
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Sewing

TV OPPORTUNITY

We're a television production company called Daisybeck Studios in Leeds and we make a number of series for major UK broadcasters, including many animal series such as 'The Yorkshire Vet' and our 'On the Farm' series' featuring Cannon Hall Farm in Barnsley.

We're delighted to have been commissioned to make series two and three of Animal Care Club for Milkshake! on Channel 5. Each episode will be around 11 minutes long, and will feature four children (working in pairs) looking after animals of all shapes and sizes! We'll be featuring farm animals, zoo animals, pets and wildlife in the series and at every opportunity children will be getting involved with animal care. It'll be a really fun, educational series and will be a fantastic experience for the children taking part.

We are currently looking at a few locations that are near to you so I thought I would get in touch to see if it might be something the children might be interested in. **Age wise, we're looking for 7-8-year-olds.** We're looking for a mix of boys/girls and diversity is also important so we can be representative of wider society to our young audience.

The children taking part would need to be off school for one day for the filming and we'd need to get child performance licenses through the local authorities. The process for this can take quite a while (up to 21 working days) so we'd be hoping to get the ball rolling as soon as we can so we can get all the paperwork in place as soon as the locations have been confirmed. The filming period is from the end of April (w/c 28th) in blocks until the 8th August, so some of the filming will fall during school holidays.

For the filming day we would need two parents/guardians to come with the children (one adult per pair) to act as chaperones. We generally find children prefer it when there's an adult there that they know, and it'll be fun for the adult too, I'm sure! If this isn't possible, we would bring in an external licensed chaperone for the filming day.

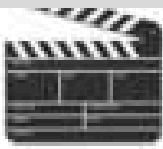

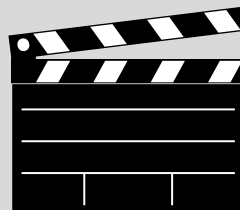

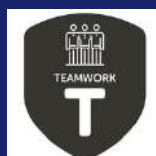
