Accommodation





Bedrooms

- Split into a boys and a girls house with separate staircases to each side.
- Rooms of between 2 and 6
- Children will be asked to give 3 names they would like to be with before going and we will try to put them with at least one. Room lists will not be given out until we arrive.
- Each room has an en-suite bathroom.
- Children will need to bring their own towels.



Meals

- Trinity house will be providing us with full board.
- Children can bring a snack for the service station on the way to Llandudno. Otherwise, they do not need to bring any food with them - any sweets will be taken off them.
- Breakfast and dinner will be eaten at Trinity House and packed lunches will be provided for day 2 and 3.
- Children will be given a choice of meals prior to trip to pre order.
- Breakfast - Cereal, toast, pastries
- Lunch - Cheese, ham or chorizo sandwiches
- Dinner 1 - Pizza
- Dinner 2 - Spaghetti Bolognese / veggie bolognese
- Evening meals will be served with a choice of sides and children will be given a choice of dessert.

Bags

- Children must be able to carry their own bags.
- The coach will be dropping is down the road from the hostel and the bedrooms are up a flight of stairs.



Day 1

- Meet in KS2 hall at 8:30 for register and toilets.
- Coach leaving Ashdene at 9am.
- Arrival in LLandudno
- Fire safety talk and check into rooms.
- Lunch from the fish and chip shop - to be pre ordered before visit.
- Afternoon will be spent exploring the town
 - Visit the pier
 - Explore the gardens
 - Walk along the beach front
- Evening meal
- Evening games in the park

- Ride on the Llandudno Tramway to the top of the Great Orme.
- Walk around the Great Orme.

Day 3

- Breakfast
- Pack
- Morning tour of Llandudno by open top bus.
- Packed lunch
- Leave Llandudno to return to school for approximately 3pm (traffic dependent).
- Pick up at 15:30 as normal from school.



Kit list

- 3 sets of day time clothes (jeans/ leggings, t shirt, jumper)
- 2 sets of evening clothes (suitable for playing sports in)
- 3 sets of underwear
- Pyjamas
- Water proofs
- Walking shoes with good grip
- Sun hat/ sun cream/ sun glasses

Medication

- In order for your child to be given any medication on the trip, a request for medication form must be completed and given to the school office.
- Please return the medication request forms by Thursday 22nd May.
- Give medication identified on the form to the trip leader, named and in the original packaging, on the morning of the trip. This includes travel sickness tablets.
- Any bottled medication must be sealed.
- Children should not carry any medication. All instructions should have been given before the trip.
- Please ensure travel sickness tablets have been taken for the journey there before you leave your child.



Money

- Children are allowed to bring £10 spending money with them on the trip.
- An ice cream and fish and chip lunch is included in the price you have already paid.
- Children can spend their money in the arcade, whilst on the pier or they can buy souvenirs during our visit to the Copper Mines.
- Your child is responsible for their own money. This should be kept in a named purse/wallet in their day bag.



Independence

- Our aim for this trip is to develop independence and encourage the children to take responsibility for themselves.
- Looking after own belongings.
- NO mobile phones, iPads or electronic devices (including air tags).
- Only contacting home through teachers in an emergency.
