A few children from Year 3 were invited to Chapel Lane to enjoy the wider VE Day celebrations, wave their flags and watch a performance by a fantastic brass band.



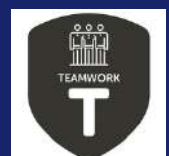
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Sport

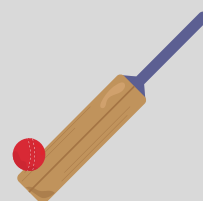
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Year 3 / 4 Cricket Festival
