In our writing we are going to use 'because' to join two sentences.

For example-

I am going to see Grandad **because** he always gives me chocolate biscuits.

Write 2 sentences using because.
They can be about anything!

Think about the features of a letter.

Start-Who are you writing to?

Paragraph 1- Why are you writing?

Paragraph 2- Explain what your doing.

End- Who is the letter from?

Today you are going to write a letter as Syd to your parents!

You are going to tell them about your adventure with Grandad and where you are.

In your letter, you are going to use because to join two sentences together.

CHALLENGE- use 's in your letter

For example
