"No, I think I'll be alright," said Grandad.

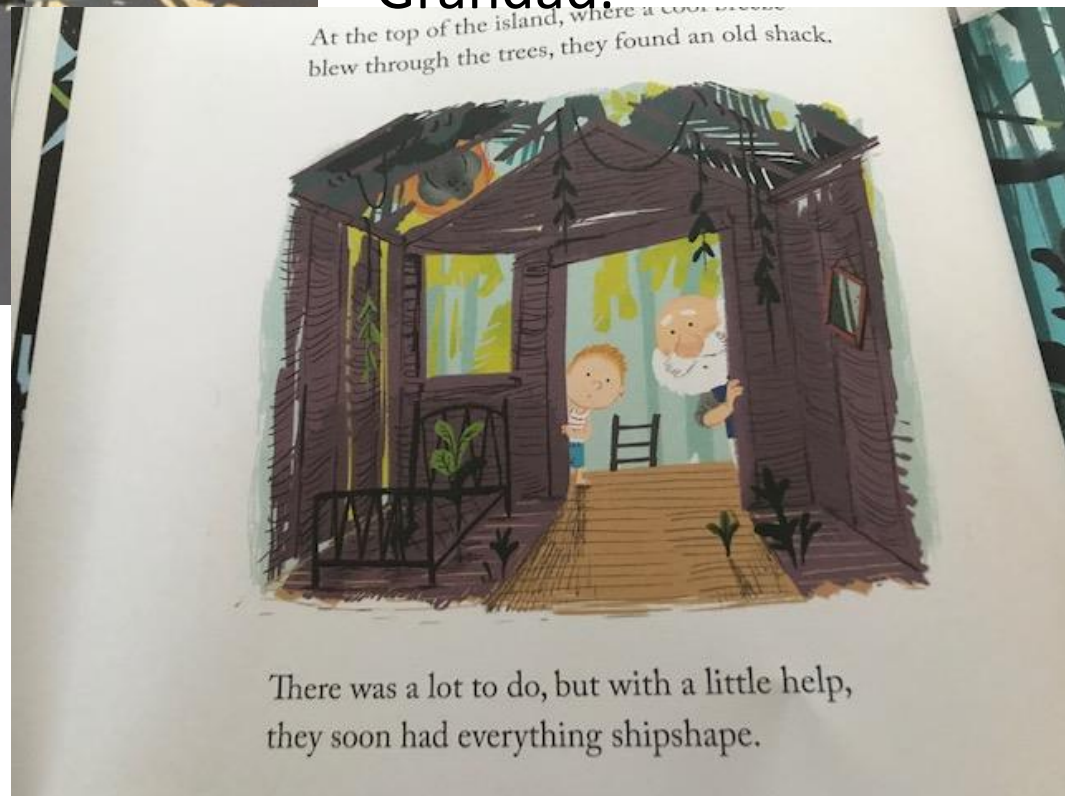




In the thick jungle of the island, it was very hot.
