Inference Answers

1.	Why do you think Wilde didn't want to be sent to Witch point?
	It's a very weird place. It is legendary for the wrong reasons - strange things happen there. She thought she would be sent home to stay with her dad.
2.	Did Wilde like her boarding school? No, she didn't like it. Wilde didn't fit in at her school and things always went wrong. She got kicked out of school on purpose.
3.	Why do you think Wilde broke out of the boarding school? She wanted to leave quickly as she was embarrassed about being escorted out under a 'shame cloud' and didn't want to sit with a disapproving adult on the three-hour train journey.
4.	Do you think Wilde was looking forward to staying with her Aunt Mae? No. She doesn't want to go there - she thought she would be sent back home to her dad but he is busy with work so they are now not speaking. Wilde is worried that her aunt will think she is peculiar.
